According to the <u>Maine Board of Overseers website</u>, "All self-study materials must be current (released within the past two years) to qualify for self-study credit." The Law and Legislative Reference Library clarified this with the Board of Overseers and their response indicated that self-study CLE credits for the reporting year 2017 would be accepted for CLEs dated 2015 forward. Carrying that interpretation to the 2018 reporting year, CLEs dated 2016 and forward will be accepted and for reporting year 2019, CLEs dated 2017 and forward will be accepted. From Board of Overseers website:

RULE CHANGE: Effective May 1, 2019, Maine's Continuing Legal Education Rule, Maine Bar Rule 5, was comprehensively amended by the Maine Supreme Judicial Court. Members of the bar are encouraged to review the amended rules as significant changes have been adopted. Of note, the annual registration and reporting of CLE credits have been bifurcated. The annual registration of attorneys will begin on July 1st as usual. Starting January 1, 2020, and each year thereafter, attorneys shall demonstrate CLE for the prior calendar year.

In order to transition from a fiscal year to a calendar year CLE reporting system, attorneys will report for calendar years 2018 (11 credits) and the 2019 CLE requirements (12) credits, for a total of 23 credits beginning January 1, 2020.

According to Maine Bar Rule 5(C)(2), ethics and H&D credits must be earned in a live CLE.
