RE: **Priorities for bills on Appropriations Table**

Pursuant to Joint Rule 314(7), we are reporting our committee's priorities for final passage of bills reported out of our committee that are now on the Appropriations Table.

Here is a summary of the priorities:

LD	1 <sup>st</sup> priority
274	3 members ranked LD 274 as their top priority; it had the highest overall ranking based on points. Representative Graham and Representative Catherine Nadeau said this is absolutely their first priority.
27	3 members ranked LD 27 as their top priority; it had the second highest overall ranking based on points.
1254	3 members ranked LD 1254 as their top priority; it had the fourth highest overall ranking based on points.
1280	1 member ranked LD 1280 as their top priority; it had the third highest overall ranking based on points.
1133	No members ranked this as their top priority; it had the lowest overall ranking based on points.
